Remote Programming Procedure You must program any and all remotes before the CompuStar is operational. Before y ou can program the remotes you must c omplete installation. Y ou must have the antenna connected to the main controller. All remotes must be programmed at the same time. Here are the steps for remote programming STEP 1 Turn the key in the ignition from the Off or ACC position to the On or IGN position 5 time s within 7 seconds. After the 5 th ignition cycle you will hear the parking light relay click. This will happen after the 5 th cycle so it is easy to mi ss. If you hear two relay clicks and parking light flashe s, the system has just ex ited remote program ming mode. STEP 2 Right a fter the 5 th cycle and hearing the first relay click A. 1 Way Remote Tap the lock button on the remote for 0.5 seconds. How to Change Options with OP500 and Remote's The options can be set using the OP5 00 Option Programmer, 1 Way remote, 2 Way remote, or the antenna button on Canadian ANT1 WA M or ANT1WSH. Option Programming Using a Remote Using a remote is a timed process so r ead this section in its entirety before beginning. If at any time during the process you hear a long horn sound the system kicked you out of programming mode. STEP 1 Select the option menu that contain s the desired programming option. Wait for a parking light flash andd siren chirp be tween each but ton press. After selecting the desired op tion number the system will confirm which option you have selected by the number of siren chi rps and parking light fla shes. STEP 3 Once the sy stem is finished confirming the option number, set the option to the desired setting by tapping buttons I or II. To set option s with the oneway remote the duration is different. Tap the Lock Button for S e tting 1. Tap th e Unlock Button for Setting 2. Resetting to Factory Defaults To reset the options in a particular menu group, enter the menu by following STEP 1, then tap button III for 0.5 sec, three ti m es. Wait for the siren to chip and parking lights to flash betw een each tap. After the thir d tap, the option m enu will reset and the siren will chirp three times. This must be done for each option group that needs to be reset. Option Programming Using the 1Way Antenna Button Programming the main contro ller option using an a ntenna is a timed process so you should rea d the instruction s entirely before begin ning. STEP 1 Turn vehicle's ignition to the on po sition. STEP 2 Selecting the Op tion Menu Select the option menu that contains the option you would like to adjust. Be aware,

the diesel time r and auxiliary times are not available when programming options with an antenna. To sele ct a menu, use the following button combinations STEP 3 Selecting the Spe cific Option After en tering the option menu that contains the option you wish to change, tap the antenna button the number of times equal to the option number.



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A few seconds after you have stopped selecting an option, the system will confirm which option you have sele cted by the nu mber of siren chirps and pa rking light flashes. STEP 4 Setting the Option After the system is finished c onfirming the option number, set the option to your desired se tting by tapp ing the antenna butto n 1 or 2 times. Resetting to Factory Defaults To reset the options in a menu, enter the menu as if you were going to program an option then hold the antenna button for three se conds. The option menu will reset and the siren will chirp three times. The options in the other three menu s will remain set. A No, this remote will only work with CM1000S control modules. How do I set reservation mode. A Reservation mode requi res connecting the e brake wire, ta ch and door tri ggers. While the vehicle is run ning with the key, set the ebrake. Wait a few seconds and then take the key out of the ignition. The vehicle should stay running un til you open and close all the doors. After a few seconds after the vehi cle stops running y ou can remote start. The progression of CompuStars brains has gone from complex programming requirements ignition ON, chirp ON, etc. to the new interface on the 4200. Be careful whose advice you buy, but be patient with those who supply it. My suggestion is to make sure that the hood pin is not grounded when you are trying to do your programing. I have not done swapping experiment of parts to make things more complicated that it already is. That said, I do know that there is a programming button on the antenna of the 4200 unit. Perhaps, you can just use the orginal antenna and make your programming selection and then change the antenna back afterward. Be careful whose advice you buy, but be patient with those who supply it.

Ill have to take a closer look at the 1W900FMR antenna.Im starting to wonder if the 1W900FMR actually has any programmable features.If Ive misinterpreted anything, let me know.I hope its just a dumb mistake on my part.Can you try to use the button IV as the trunk to see if you getting any respond with this. Be careful whose advice you buy, but be patient with those who supply it. The trunk which Ive been calling III requires a 2 second hold before the lights flash, while the start which Ive been calling IV just takes a half second before the lights flash. But I can even mix and match using both buttons to get to three times before I get the 3 flashes and go out of programming mode. It seems the remote is sending the same frequency for both buttons or the brain is interpreting both buttons the same.It sounds like it is much easier to get into programming mode.Any user assumes the entire risk as to the accuracy and use of this information.
