Its probably a long shot, but I was wondering if anyone had a schematic for this amp. Id like to try to repair it. The SA20 is known for blown output transistors, which also happen to be discontinued and unavailable. There are options, however. A rebuild service will cost you an arm and a leg but it is available HERE. You can also buy the full schematic there as well. Alternatively you can get the bias circuit HERE. Id move on to a different amp if I were you. Unfortunately AltaVista is out of business. I think I may end up using building a new amp using the chassis and power supply. Fortunately, the SA3000 preamp that came in the box seems to be working great. All rights reserved Back to top. Thanks, MattIf you dont find the bridge or the filter capacitor to be shorted, then disconnect the secondary by carefully noting and insulating each wire, and then power the primary with a fuse installed. If the fuse still blows, your transformer is defective. Gajanan PhadteI would start there not a great design from a reliability standpoint decent sound. I wired a 60 watt incandescent bulb in line between the amp and my variac and started pulling the transformer outputs 1 by 1, taping them off and then running up the voltage. At 20 volts the bulb begins to glow and by 40 its pretty bright. This occurred all the way through until every out put wire was taped off. Hence I believe that the transformer is shot. Thanks to a couple of very cool people I managed to get a schematic for this unit and swore upon pain of death that I wouldnt post it but I would still like a little advice on how to find a replacement. As this is a hybrid amp it seems likes its going to be pretty difficult to find. By my reading it has 2 x 295v, 2 x 6v, 2 x 7v and 2 x 68v but this voltage on the schematic is after the rectifier so I would assume that there would be some drop. If anyone has any suggestions I sure would appreciate it!!!Wouldnt a light connected as you describe turn on regardless of transformer fault. It started having problems shortly after I replaced the tubes in it, with ElectroHarmonix 6922 tubes. The left channel would make distortion and later the right channel too, especially at low frequencies. I just let it run like that for a year since this was just used for TV speakers. But, then things got worse and the left channel quit working altogether. I see the gate stopper resistors are blown on the NChannel devices. They smolder and smoke when turned on. So, the output transistors are toast as well. I dont know what blew the transistors though, unless it happened when a tube died. Maybe a large transient blew the gates. But the gates are protected with diodes. It looks like the tubes are capacitively coupled to the gates with Wima 1uF caps. Those might need to be replaced as well. Id like to find a schematic for this, if its out there. It would help, though I think I can do the repair without one. The left channel seems to work okay now with the new [] 6922 tubes. It seems to be just a matter of blown output transistors. They are the 75 watt IRF130 and I can get replacements at Mouser. One other thing. Both channels have been running really cool ice cold for years. They used to run fairly hot. I didnt think MOSFETs need bias adjustment, but I guess they might after all this time. Or maybe Counterpoint adjusted the bias to run cooler after I stuffed it under a cabinet once and it over heated, and got damaged. Well, probably not. The potentiometers for bias and DC offset are labeled, so that should be easy enough to fix.

Got to these babies cooking again. If I get the problem fixed I may also do some mods, but one thing at a time. This would have blown the snubber zeners also. I would pull out those caps and check, or just replace them. Also check voltages, without the caps in the circuit, on the tube and solid state side separately to try and isolate a problem before reinstalling them. I would also replace the bias adjust transistor and check all the power supply voltages before installing the new output transistors. Okay, I took your advice and looked into it. That seemed like most logical explanation,

but then I think I found the problem. Okay, well this amp is actually an SA12 that was supposedly modified to be a SA100. We never were sure because of a mixup we had with the dealer, who said they didnt modify it cause they didnt bill us for it. But, months later he said they did, but he didnt bill us for it cause of the mixup. But, it never did look modified to me and this circuit board is the same board as the SA12 an 80 watt amp. Anyway, I turned it on and measured 157 volts across the coupling cap. And the heater supply only puts out 257 volts. And there is a relay which connects the gates to ground on turn on to prevent thumps and stuff. So, while its warming up at least, for a couple minutes, there is 44 volts across the gate resistors. When the relay turns off there should be 44 volts at the gate, and not much current should pass through the protection zeners. But I didnt wait that long to measure it cause if the resistors blow then there goes the relay and maybe power supply. So, thats why they are smoking. They are dissipating 4.6 watts. So, I think Ill replace some of things you mentioned anyways just to be careful, and maybe do some upgrades. Glad the tubes and other components are likely okay. Anyway, its good to get your help on this. Thanks a bunch Nick.





I checked out Mike Elliots instructions, and I dont think Ill be buying 1000 IRF130s and IRF9130s, burning them in, and matching them. So, I guess that means using source resistors at the output. I think Ill fix one channel also replacing the diodes and gate resistors, of course. Ill check out the relay and Vbe multiplier 2N2222 transistor make sure those are working. Im glad Newark has those transistors. Thats a start. Then Ill compare both channels and if the new channel sounds good Ill do the left channel too and some other mods. So adding that to the 0.22 ohms emitter resistors the damping factor would be pretty bad. Mike Elliot said adding the emitter resistors also hurt sound quality. So, I may find some other TO220 mosfets with low on resistance and low capacitance to fix the amp. Not sure what I will to do at this point though. The Newark site has a pdf data sheet at the bottom of the page. For the IRF130 For the IRF9130 Though, Im not sure which way Im going on this project right now. If I think I can repair it so it sounds as good or better, without spending too much, I will probably do that. But I enjoy just thinking about different things too, and how I could maybe make an improvement to the amp. Right now Im thinking maybe paralleling four IRF520 and its compliment, four IRF9520, for each channel. Even with the 22 ohm source resistors on each source the output resistance would be only.12. Plus, it would have an overall higher transconductance and just slightly more capacitance. Yeah, I welcome any ideas really, on parts or circuit mods. Im just kind of brain storming right now. I was just informed that Mike has stopped all business because of health reasons. The Alta Vista Website confirms this. I know some of you may have had some issues dealing with Mike in the past but Mike was always a professional to me and accommodating to all of my dumb questions. I learned so much from his designs and I know that they were way ahead of their time.



I just finished modifying an SA5000 for a few audiophiles based on the information provided on the Alta Vista Audio website and they sound excellent. I still own the current version of the NP220 power amp. Well my thoughts and prayers go out to Mike and his family. Thanks Mike for everything. So sorry to hear that. Mike Elliott was one of the several people who sparked my interest in DIY and mods. I have learnt a lot from this eccentric genius over the years. I was also fortunate enough to meet many fellow audiophiles around the world who are into Counterpoint and Aria amps, not to mention having the pleasure of meeting several friendly audiogon members here in the Bay Area and have fun with NP tweaks and repairs. I wish Mike all the best and a speedy recovery whatever his ailment is. I hope between Bigkidz and myself we have enough knowledge base for NP power amps to support the existing fan base. My mistake on jumping the gun on Mikes health. He is alive and doing well. I emailed Mike and he will put my contact information on the Alta Vista Website for Counterpoint repairs and upgrades. If you need any service, feel free to contact me to discuss your particular needs. I recently upgraded two SA5000s preamps and they sounded fantastic, much better than the stock units since I had the two at the same time, I was able to compare each upgrade performed to determine the outcome and actually heard the differences. Beides Counterpoint products, I am available to repair or modify all audio components CD Players, preamps, amps, DACs, etc. Happy Listening. I have send an email to Mike. I know technicans that lost its job due to the current financial situation. Some of them have over 40 years in repairing hifi eletronics. job without training or overpaying them too much. I would be glad if anyone does have a working email. I could just let him know the addresses. Hello Bigkidz. Ive a SA5000 for several years. I recently opened the case to clean for dust, with a brush and by blowing air. Ive also cleaned the pins of tubes and sockets with an electronic contact spray cleaner. Now i hear a loud whiff or blow on both the channels using phono input MM. I exchanged the tubes but it doesnt go away. I suspect that it is a problem from power supply, where is the only tube I didnt change. I was attracted from some kind of upgrade, but now i have to repair it, before. Do you have the service manual of the SA5000. Or can you help me to find it or with any other suggestion. Thanks in advance, Luca. Im late to the party. I have a Counterpoint amp, originally SA 20 upgraded before I bought it to NP220 and I had this work done by MikeUpgrade Basic Board to Premium Board, Upgrade remainder of amp to Gold level, Vanden Hul wiring, new Nichicon caps, I had already upgraded the transformer. Unfortunately I didnt save any further documentation of the upgrades. If anyone can tell me where that might be, Id appreciate it. Also, Id be interested in what are replacement tubes. O havent done any such, but Im going on 10 years since the last upgrade. FYI I can fix, rebuild, modify any component or build something to your liking. If you want to ship something overseas, I can do that for you also. I think they sound better than the mosfets and I think the amps sound better than the original NP amps that Mike designed. I have compared them directly now that I get them into repair. I also add a few additional modifications that I use in my own designs. My prices are about half of what Alta Vista charged. Send me a message though Agon if you need to contact me. The Alta Vista website seems to be gone.

I have the schematics and I have serviced no less than 5 of them. Most of them have failures like popping caps, rustling plate resistors, blown rectifier 6CA4 and blown Zeners. Why would anyone take out 3 valves. I assume they are the 12AX7 error amp and the 6922 pass element in the regulator section. The SA5000, unlike the 3000 and 2000, is a bit tough to service due to the floating chassis and the rather delicate regulator section. Good luck finding someone to rebuild it. IMO you might want to find a used unit on Ebay rather than trying to rebuild a butchered unit. Please do not offer the downloaded file for sell only use it for personal usage. May 23, 2017 Schematic of Counterpoint SA5000 preamplifier Dear friends, Im writing from Spain. I have a preamplifier SA5000. Faceplate and body are very clean with some minor scuff marks and nicks. This Hybrid Tube preamp uses a single 6DJB for the hybrid line stage and and two 12AX7 Tubes for the all tube phono stage. The Phono section can be configure for Low output or High output

cartridges. This is a one owner unit, bought new in 1992. The piece has been in storage in a temperature controlled environment for the past seven years. The unit has been well cared for and has not been modified. Original owners manual and sales literature are included with the preamp. Sleek though the 7 may have been, it couldnt have been too comfortable for the tubes to be lying on their sides in a shallow chassis. In the SA1000 they stand upright, with plenty of breathing space. It also allows for a lesscluttered fascia, though I must admit that the slighty assymetrical hodgepodge and undersized controls favoured by the company help neither the aesthetics nor the ergonomics.

No complaints here, as thats all you need, though I wouldnt have minded a polarity inversion switch on a product from a company which championed the facility. The only unusual facility is the choice of phono settings, the unit arriving in a high gain mode ideal for the majority of moving coils. This activates the low gain setting while deactivating the high gain option. Counterpoint feels that keeping both active would degrade the sound, so the user makes a choice. One other option is available to phono users who dont like 47k Ohm loading for mcs. Two sets of internally positioned sockets will accept loading resistors should you wish to tailor the sound to best suit an mc unhappy with the factory setting. Aside from the phono adjustments, the only effort demanded of the SA1000 beyond basic hookup is the installation of the three valves; removal of the lid for this procedure presents the perfect opportunity for setting the phono section, ideal if you dont want to keep removing the lid. The valve complement consists of a pair of 12AX7s and a single 6DJ8, clearly identified and easy to install. A pleasant surprise for those moving from an SA7 to an SA1000, in addition to owning a preamp which you can touch without sending a thump or ringing through the speakers, is the presence of an automuting circuit which eliminates the clicks and pops that made you feel a Kelloggs logo would have been a more apt decoration for the fascia. The SA1000 uses triodes for all amplification stages, with the pair of dualtriode 12AX7 in the phono circuit and each half of the 6DJ8 providing line stage voltage gain for each channel; a MOSFET supplies current gain. A capacitor prevents DC from reaching the outputs. Chorus of deep sighs of relief. The power supply consists of a high voltage winding off the transformer for the main amplification stages, with a low voltage winding to supply filament voltage, all fully rectified.

I do not use the 6CG7 in the phono section of my Counterpoint mainly due to gain and micorphonics issues, although. I get a fuller sound than with any 6922 or 6DJ8 type. Counterpoint approved substitute in this amp. Not su. Aside from replacing tubes every 3 years or so, its been just steady. Does anyone have expereience with this amp and tubes. All suggestions. I recall recapping a 3 using a Sprague 96 uF electrolytic at 450 Volts. It was sized sorry working off memory here and its been a decade since I worked on it about4. The schematics are RIDICULOUSLY priced on the Counterpointe website and all I need is a picture of the power supply secti.

And if youre interested, Ill be posting a review in about a week or so on his upgrade to my Counterpoint SA2000 the 3000 minus phono stage. Jim. Thanks Mark. Got them very economical probably for their notoriety. My original tubes were Mullards as well, though n. For some reason I think the tubes were Sylvania, but really, I have no idea. Presently looking for replacements, but new. I find it very smooth and sweet sounding. However, be forewarned. The outputs in all the older Counterpoint amps are proprietary Harris M. Does anyone know the spec of the SA7.1 transformer Want t. What have you found that works really well in the input section of the amp. Twas I who started this thread. Couldnt I go cathode follower to reduce the gain. I wish to use a Decca Gold i. Emphasis on the word starter. Not knowing what you are changing from its difficult to say how much WoW voull experience. Most definitely you will want to put some. Since these are driver tubes I assume tat NOS is not needed. Any suggestions would be welcome. Thanks TOPIC. Also I hear the nic. Probably my first priority is to get something that does well with the Citation, so looking at some ARC SP11, as you suggest.
