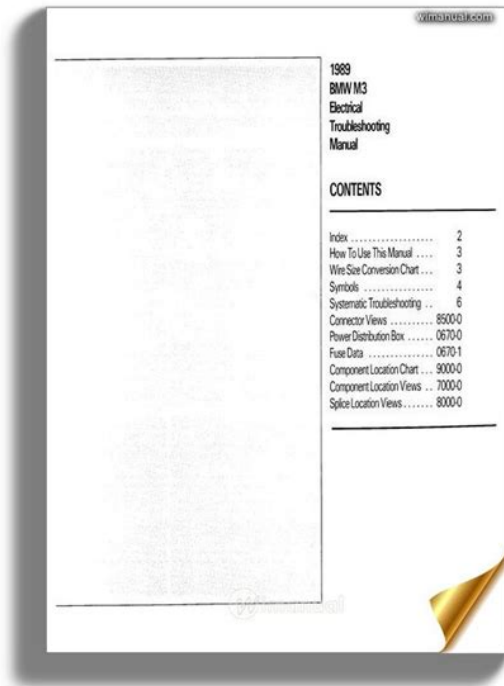

Even well within wattage specs, both units locked themselves to 100% and stopped responding to DMX at random intervals. Only a powercycle of each unit would return the logic board to normal operation. The digital readout on each unit would flicker random characters and would only show numbers again if we hit the unit hard. Something is wrong with the design of these units. Only real complaint is that the lock feature in the menu isn't retained when power is turned off, so it returns to unlocked when powered up again. Wouldn't be so much of a problem, except that hitting the wrong button in an unlocked state will change the DMX addresses. Not a good thing in the middle of a performance. Hasn't happened to me yet, probably because I try to keep them out of easy reach. But someday. Easy to program and works perfectly. Doesn't matter where in the chain I put it, or which device is next, whatever it is gets bad data. Had to run a separate universe for just the Leviton dimmers, which is silly. Hook it up and it doesn't work. One of the worst kinds of errors to have in a unit that you depend on. Would not buy again. 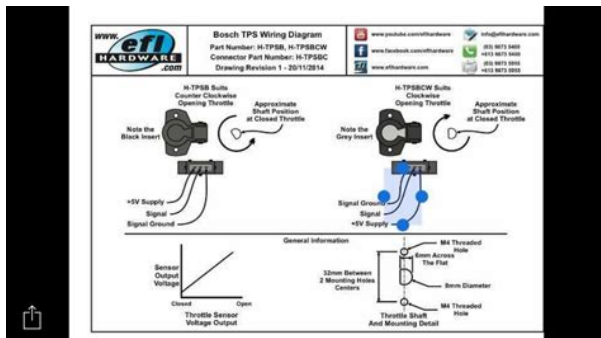

Dimmer 1 Small occasional flicker, wont dim. Keeps the channel totally off while fader is at 049% and full on while fader is at 50100%. Happens on all 4 channels, dims using front panel buttons, but not over dmx. Tried different power source and dmx, nothing changed. Dimmer 2 Channel 3 is stuck at full power. Tried changing address, power cycling and checked that it was not left on in the channel tester. Dimmer 3 Wont receive any DMX on verified working DMX line. DMX receiving led not on. Receiving power and dimming manually. Im using a MA dot2 console. I do have some backup dimmers that I can pull from a different venue if need be, and they are all the same model. Its not unusual for a short or power surge in a DMX run to take out several things at once. Its part of why optical splitters are a good idea. 2 sounds like the dimmer module has gone bad.

When choosing lighting for these rooms, I had a few criteria in mind. First, we don't do heavy lighting effects, and so we don't have great lighting needs. What we were going for is even front white light across the stage, and some color accent light for backlight or wall light. Second, budget was tight, so I had be very conservative. Here's the list It's a triLED fixture, so you don't get that weird 3color

look like you do from so many of them. The dimming curve is reasonable, and the colors are very acceptable for what we're doing. Sure, it can't keep up with a ColorBlast, but then again, I can buy 6 of these fixtures for every ColorBlast, so it's a win. We lamped them down to 375 HPLs so they wouldn't need to be run at 50% to keep the light level acceptable. The OptiPar is basically a poor ripoff of an ETC Parnell, and it's not a particularly good ripoff, but they work OK. Given the fact that we would focus them and forget them, they will suffice. And since they were already in stock and not being used, it was easy on the budget. I personally like these boards a lot.

You can also connect them to a computer via USB and run software that will give you full control of the system, including patching and all set up. Save the show to the hard drive, and if someone really hoses the console, it's a simple matter to restore it. And if you have LogMeIn on that computer, well, you get the idea. I looked for a better dimming solution, but couldn't find one. I considered doing centralized dimming, but the layout of the building didn't make that easy. And when we added up all the cabling, installation and dimming costs, it didn't make economic sense. When you figure the NSI dimmer is well under two bills, it's hard to say no. We have several in our other rooms, and they work fine for 45 years. At that point, it's easy to replace them. Next year, I'll probably order one or two to have on hand, just in case. The smallest stage—in our 4th/5th grade room—gets just two OptiPars and 4 Tri7X's. In that room, the LEDs splash color on the walls. In the K3 room, we have four OptiPars spread out to cover the 16' wide stage, and three LEDs upstage aimed as backlights. The largest room—Student Life—got six OptiPars, again spread to cover the 36' wide stage, and five LEDs, again aimed as backlight. In all the rooms, we channeled the LEDs in an even/odd fashion so we can create multiple color looks easily. Eventually, we'll program in a bunch of preset looks that can be manually selected or programmed into a stack. Thankfully, Monoprice sells power extension cables in varying lengths that work just great for that purpose. Since the fixtures draw almost no power, we powered them from the same power outlet we used for the PA which is powered from the Furman's at FOH, via Gepco's RunOne cable. We'll get into that later. I could have chosen a cheaper console, but I really like the SmartFades, and they've proven to be ultrareliable. And everyone is amazed at the results. So I think we did OK. Next up, audio. Established in 1966, Heil Sound Ltd.

How to lead as a volunteer, building great teams, how to grow as a tech leader and choosing the right console. It's a great discussion. After a much needed day off on Monday, we hit the ground running for the final sprint to the finish. This past weekend was opening weekend, and while the project is not completely finished, it was done enough to open and serve our kids and students ministries. My goal was to have my stuff wrapped up by Friday night, and since I left the building at 11:30 PM, I made the goal! Though I was exhausted this weekend, it was very satisfying to see the rooms teeming with kids and students. In fact, we had larger attendance in many of our age groups than ever. So that's pretty neat. Already God is using these rooms to change lives, which is of course, the whole point. Overall, I'm extremely pleased with how things worked out. Aside from a few minor snafus which we'll talk about in future posts, everything worked as planned. I have a lot of lessons learned through this process as well, and I'll be detailing those here in the coming weeks. But adding the carpet made it all work. We went with a 2x2 square tile, which are easily replaced if they get damaged or stained. It's a cool look that should look good for a long time. As you can see, we are running an Apple TV in here and in the other rooms as well. I'll detail the connections at a later date, but know that it does work, and it is really sweet to be able to walk into a room, hit the Apple TV and be streaming music from my iPhone to the PA in seconds. Since we used a GB224 in the Student Life room, we went with a fullwidth counter. I decided to mount the rack to the underside of the counter, but that led to the question of how we were going to get behind there to make connections, or work on gear. Being versed in cabinet making, I went back to my kitchen building days and ordered up

some fulllength drawer slides. Mounted to 2x4s screwed to the underside of the counter and boom.

We decided to carpet it in black, which I think was the right call. The sculpture on the wall still in progress in this photo was dreamed up by our Youth Pastor Jason. Now that its done framed in burlapwrapped 1x6, it looks very cool. Eventually, well be putting some wall controls for our EZ Button system in the empty boxes in the wall there. Since they werent needed for opening weekend, they got pushed off. We chose different color stains for each of the tech booths to match something that was going on in each room. As you can tell, we still need to get another coat of eggshell yellow on the booth, but that will get done eventually. Painting was a bear on this job. Its a smaller stage 8x8, which suits what they like to do in there. Its typically 12 musicians and a group of 4050 kids. Again, Jason dreamed up the slat wall, which looks really great in here. Eventually well get doors on the booths as well to keep too many kids from hanging out in there. All the stages are carpeted with the same black carpet and rubber nosing, which should hopefully last a long time. First, the carpet guys hit it with vinyl cove base before I could get my wooden base on which meant a lot less staining and finishing for me. Second, its chromakey green so we can use it for video shoots now. Finally, Im a huge fan of the natural wood stain. With this color, the Douglas Fir looks a lot like natural cherry, which is my favorite wood. And who doesnt love bright orange door jambs Though I was mixing FOH in the main room this weekend, I did manage to sneak out and snap a quick picture of my daughter, Robyn, leading worship for Flood. I had to leave after a minute because I actually became quite emotional seeing the results of 6 long weeks of hard work. The fact that my daughter is the worship leader for Flood is an extra bonus.

There were many times when I wanted to quit and times when I thought it would never end, but knowing we now have some incredible space for our ministries to use that will impact lives for eternity makes all the long, hot hours well worth it. Sure, we'll be fully functional this coming weekend when we open the new space, but there will be system processors to adjust, lights to program or refocus, and probably some networking to do. So, during the first week of the project, I booked a flight to a favorite city. I started to plan the things I wanted to do and see. I booked a rental car and hotel, and planned to stay with some friends. This serves two purposes. First, it gives me something to look forward to. As I was getting up for the 38th straight day in a row, knowing that I was just a few weeks away from being able to enjoy some time in the woods by myself was most encouraging.

I can't go in to the office if I'm not in the same state. I booked my flight for my 4th day off; that gives me time to sleep in, rest and take some naps before I head off. But just about the time I'd be tempted to head in to "check on things," I'll be boarding a plane. I know we are shorthanded right now so my ATD, Jon, will bear the brunt of that on his own those two weekends I'm gone. But he's fully capable of making it happen. There will be paperwork that I won't get done until I get back, and accounting will have to live with that. A few things will go unfinished for a few weeks, but that's OK. I need to get healthy again before I return. Socrates once said, "The unexamined life is not worth living." I

believe it's important we get to know ourselves, and our weaknesses so that we can plan for them and protect ourselves. Of course, my weaknesses may not be yours, and you need to figure out what you need to learn about yourself to be most productive and healthy.
